Client need:

The European Pipe Band Championship was expected to attract around 25,000 people and Inverclyde Council needed to provide facilities for the visitors, performers and VIPs, ensuring a memorable event with no inconvenience. They wanted to install mains connected toilet blocks and a number of cabins for first aid, security and administration.

Our solution:

The site proved unsuitable for mains toilet blocks. After winning the contract under competitive tender, RB Farquhar advised the client on the flexibility of their range of portable chemical toilet facilities and in particular the quality of our single WC units. We supplied four types of toilet for the championships:

- Basic Single Toilet Unit
- Disabled Units
- Urinal Blocks
- Luxury Loos

In addition to the conveniences and cabins, we also supplied toilet attendants to ensure a high standard of provision throughout the event. RB Farquhar were also able to be flexible in response to the client's changing requirements as planning for the event progressed.
