Client need:

The Glasgow River Festival is a popular established event and in 2006 crowds in excess of 50,000 were expected to attend. The event took place at a number of locations on the River Clyde and event organisers, Richmond Event Management, wanted to provide enough toilet facilities to ensure the three day festival went off without a hitch. In addition, they needed temporary offices to serve as administration posts. The units needed to be delivered onsite early on the first day and removed promptly once the event was over. A high standard of service and quality was demanded over the entire course of the three day event and there was a tight budget to meet.

Our solution:

RB Farquhar worked closely with the client in the six month planning phase in advance of the event, advising on the suitability of units and their location, and reacting quickly to changes requirements.
